

Camp Locations & General Information

- PreSchool Camp will take place in the theater & some activities will be outside
- Elementary Camp will take place in the dance studio & some activities will be outside
- This year campers from the two camps will not intermingle.
- Each group will stay in their "home base" and the teachers will move to them
- We regret that we will not be able to have a live, culminating performance for all campers and their families on Friday. However, some type of performance will be recorded and posted for families to see.
- All campers must wear a cloth mask. If a camper arrives without a mask he/she will not be permitted to attend
 camp. We recognize this will be challenging for our youngest campers. We will help them cope and we will
 make it fun. Please work with your child in advance to explain why this is necessary and help them practice
 wearing their mask before the first day of camp.
- All campers will have a designated "special spot" in the room. These will be taped off, a minimum of 6 feet apart, and will be labeled with their name.
- Campers will use hand sanitizer and/or wash their hands when they enter the building and at least once every hour of camp.
- Parents please maintain social distancing when you are dropping off and picking up your children
- Please avoid coming to the office as much as possible
- Campers may not come to camp if they are sick, have a temperature or have been around anyone who is sick or tested positive for the Covid 19 virus or the flu.
- We are considering taking each camper's temperature with a no touch infrared thermometer before they enter camp, but are still seeking guidance on this issue.

Drop Off and Pick-Up

- Campers may not arrive more than 5 minutes before camp starts (8:55)
- Camp parents will only use the rear entrance of the building. The front doors will be locked.
- Please use the stairs. The elevator will be turned off.
- PreSchool campers will be dropped off outside the theater door (second level).
 - Spaces will be designated for each camper's belongings in the balcony area
 - Parents are asked to say good-byes outside the theater
 - We will leave the blinds up so parents may peek in the windows! :)
- **Elementary Camp** will take place in the dance studio and campers will be dropped off at the top balcony (3rd level)
 - Spaces will be designated for each camper's belongings in the balcony area
 - Parents are asked to say good-byes outside the dance studio

Other Considerations

We are still awaiting further day camp guidance from the NC Department of Health and Human Services. Once these guidelines are available we may have to adjust our procedures and precautions. Our goal with this email was to give you general information so you can make a decision about attending camp. We will keep you posted as updates are made and we will send all families reminders about the policies before camps start.
